### ANNUAL KIDS FISHING DERBY

#### RULES

- 1 All contestants must be 13 years of age or under and do their own fishing.
- 2 All contestants must register, pay their entry fee and pick up their tackle at the registration table before starting to fish.
- 3 All contestants must use the pole, tackle and worms provided by the Beaverton & District Conservation Club.
- 4 All fish caught must be brought to the registration table to be measured and recorded.
- 5 The derby will last from 9:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 6 When the horn sounds at the end of the derby there will no further catches recorded and all contestants must return their tackle to the registration table.
- 7 There will be a \$150.00 prize for the girl catching the longest fish and a \$150.00 prize for the boy catching the longest fish.
- 8 Prizes will be handed out to the boy and girl who caught the longest fish at the registration table at the end of the derby. Winners must be present!
- 9 The decisions of the Fishing Derby Committee will be final.
- 10 The derby will be **LIVE RE|LEASE** except for invasive species.
